



SOLAR GRANT DELAWARE INCENTIVES

Effective July 1, 2026

GRANT	Residential	Non-Residential
Price per watt	\$0.70/eligible watt	\$0.70/eligible watt
Maximum Amount	\$5,000	\$20,000

To qualify for the Solar Grant Delaware incentive rates above, Part Two of the application must be submitted on or after July 1, 2026.

Grant funding is limited and is provided on a first-come first-serve basis. Part One of the grant application must be submitted by the contractor or system owner to reserve funding. Part Two of the grant application must be submitted after final interconnection approval and within six months of the Program Admin's verification of Part One. Failure to submit Part Two within the allotted timeframe may result in the application being canceled.

NOTES:

- These incentives apply to Delaware Electric Cooperative (DEC) customers only.
- Grant applications are evaluated by site address, not electric meter.
- The solar system must be installed by an approved contractor.
- The grant amount is determined based on the eligible system size.
- The system owner must agree to the transfer of ownership of the system's Solar Renewable Energy Credits (SRECs) to obtain the grant. Failure to agree to the transfer will result in dismissal of the grant.
- Applications with Part Two submitted on or before June 30, 2026, will be processed under the previous incentive structure: \$0.70 per eligible watt, capped at \$2,000 for residential and \$0.70 per eligible watt, capped at \$10,000 for non-residential.
